



# Information about changes in MSW regarding pilot orders

# The regulations

New regulations regarding pilot orders enter into force on December 1, 2023. The Swedish Maritime Administration's new regulations<sup>1</sup> state that preliminary pilot orders should be made in Maritime Single Window (MSW Reportal) in connection with reporting the ship's notification of arrival and departure. These new regulations follow the new regulations on pilotage from the Swedish Transport Agency, entering into force on the same date. The technical changes in MSW Reportal will be implemented through an update between 09:00-11:00, on Friday December 1.

# **Important news**

# Preliminary pilot orders in connection with the ship's notification

Ships are no longer required to submit a notification of the need for pilotage. Instead, it will be mandatory to make a preliminary pilot order in connection with the ship's reporting in accordance with section 6 of the Swedish Transport Agency's regulations and general recommendations (TSFS 2010:159) on reporting obligations for vessels in certain cases, in many cases 24 hours before ETA (Estimated Time of Arrival).

Earlier submission of preliminary pilot orders makes it easier to anticipate the need for pilots, which increases the Swedish Maritime Administration's ability to meet the ships' requested time for pilotage.

A consequence of submitting the preliminary pilot orders earlier is that boarding point and requested starting time should be submitted at the same time together with the endpoint in port and ETA that are already mandatory when reporting the ship's notification.

# Pilot order is the default setting for larger ships

When reporting a ship of at least either 70 meters length over all or 20 meters breadth, the default setting in MSW Reportal will be that a pilot order should be made. If the ship uses a pilot exemption certificate or is exempted from pilotage in accordance with the Swedish Transport Agency's regulations, the person reporting in MSW Reportal will have to manually change the pilotage status.

It will still be possible to choose to order a pilot, if the ship is smaller than either 70 meters length over all or 20 meters breadth or if the ship uses a pilot exemption certificate.

#### New pilotage statuses

New pilotage statuses will be used in MSW:

- Required to employ pilot
- Pilot exemption certificate (PEC)
- Not required to employ pilot
- Exempted from compulsory pilotage

Vhen you have selected the ship, he pilotage status will be utomatically set to "Required to mploy pilot" if the ship is at least 0 m long or 20 m wide.

Regardless of ship size, you can choose one of four possible pilotage statuses:

- Required to employ pilot
- Pilot exemption certificate (PEC)
- Not required to employ pilot
- Exempted from compulsory pilotage

# Pilotage/movement
